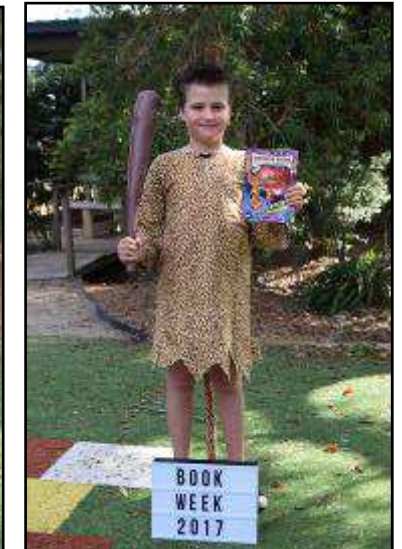
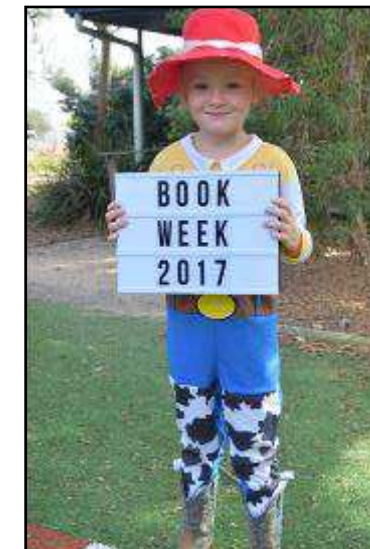
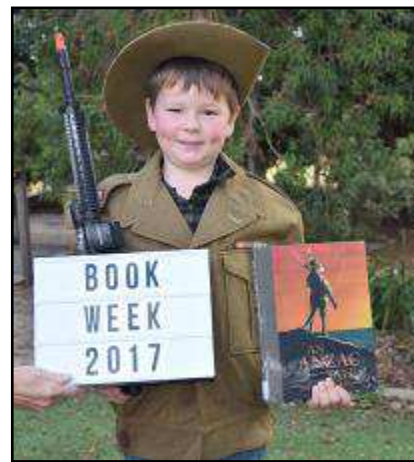
Year 1 and 2 students can sleep over for the night. Prep students go home with parents and come to school as normal on Thursday.
