TRIPLE P SEMINARS – POSITIVE PARENTING IN A NUTSHELL

IS THIS YOU?

Most of the time, parenting is fun. You know you are doing a good job. But there are times when things get a little tricky. Like when your toddler won't eat her dinner. Or your six year old won't pick up his toys. If only someone could give you some ideas to make those times easier! If this sounds like you, then a Triple P Seminar may be right for you.

WHAT ARE TRIPLE P SEMINARS?

Triple P Seminars are for large groups of parents – possibly 20 or more. It's an informal presentation, a little like a public forum. There are three seminars in the Triple P series and you can choose to do one, two or all three:

- **The Power of Positive Parenting:** For every parent who ever wondered: "Why does my child do that?" This seminar helps you understand the reasons kids do what they do, so you can guide their behaviour – and see more of the behaviour you like, and less of the behaviour you don't like.
- **Raising Confident, Competent Children:** You can help your child become confident and successful – at school and beyond. Find out ways to encourage them be respectful and considerate, communicate and get on well with others, feel good about themselves and become independent problem solvers.
- **Raising Resilient Children:** How can you help your child manage their emotions so they cope well with disappointment and in stressful situations? Get the strategies that will allow them to recognise positive and negative emotions – and deal with them in a healthy way.

All goods are being tendered on an "as is" basis.


The tender items are available for inspection in the office.

Columboola Science Trailer

We had so much fun with the people from the Columboola Education Centre. The two teachers we had were Dean and Robyn. Robyn had the students in grade P-2 and Dean had the students in grade 3-6. The activities we did related to a sport in the Olympics.



The students in grade 3-6 had to work in groups to create their own model of a rocket using a bottle, a paper plate, cardboard and tape. They filled their rockets with water (fuel) and placed them on a launch pad. Dean pumped air into the bottle and the students pulled a string to launch it.

The Juniors talked about forces: push, pull and twist. They chose group leaders and

the leaders got given a bag. In the bag was one egg with slime in it, a toy car, a spinning top and a bat & ball. They experimented with their chosen object and wrote down if you could push it or pull it. The group leaders then got a box and in the box were dodge balls, straws for archery, cans for weightlifting, bats & balls for table tennis and



for soccer they had

tennis balls. They

tested each object to decide if it moved with a push, a pull or both.
