This funding will be used to

- Reading- 100% of students not on an Individual Curriculum Plan achieve Darling Downs South West regional benchmark using diagnostic tests
- Reading- Increase scale score in Naplan reading for year 5 students- measured using year 3-5 growth
- Reading- All year 3 and 5 students to achieve at or above National minimum standard in Naplan

Our initiatives include

- provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against Annual improvement plan targets and regional benchmarks (Multilit, Big 6)
- support teacher aides to extend student learning in reading in the early years of primary school (Big 6)
- develop a plan for monitoring early phase literacy and numeracy, including the schedule of Early Start assessments, opportunities for professional conversations regarding student progress and strategies for intervention
- Increase speech language pathologist time to provide skills and expertise to staff and students in the area of language development (Big 6)
- Promoting reading for pleasure through a variety of programs and whole school systems

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- use Early Start materials across Prep to Year 2 to inform teaching, learning and resourcing, and to track progress
- Use Multilit materials to deliver literacy based programs to all students in the prep year, and identified students from years 1-6
- Implement Scholastic Learning Zone and Lexile library borrowing for all students (\$3500)
- Providing teacher aide and Teacher relief scheme support to early year's teachers to conduct Early Start testing for students in prep, year 1 and year 2. (\$5500)
- analyse current reading program to ensure all aspects of teaching reading are being met, using the Big 6 Framework as a guide
- Utilising the Speech language pathologist to deliver an explicit vocabulary program, and teacher and teacher aide support, for all students in years P-4 (\$17000)
